NEW FEES FOR 2008

CHANGES EFFECTIVE MARCH 3rd

DETROIT- On Monday, **March 3, 2008**, new user fees will go into effect regarding services that were once provided by the Detroit Police Department at no charge. The increased fees being introduced are now comparable to those in other cities that provide similar services. There is no profit being made from the fee increase. The fees cover the cost of the administrative duties associated with applicant investigations and data processing and storage. The updated fee chart affect services related to liquor license investigations of both corporate and individual applications as well as 24-hour temporary permits. Additionally, fees for “vehicle for hire” license applications, “vehicle identification number” (VIN) inspections and “Cop View” CD-ROM videos will also increase.
